Welcome to EC-Earth General Assembly 2025 in Stockholm

From Stockholm Arlanda Airport (ARN) to the City

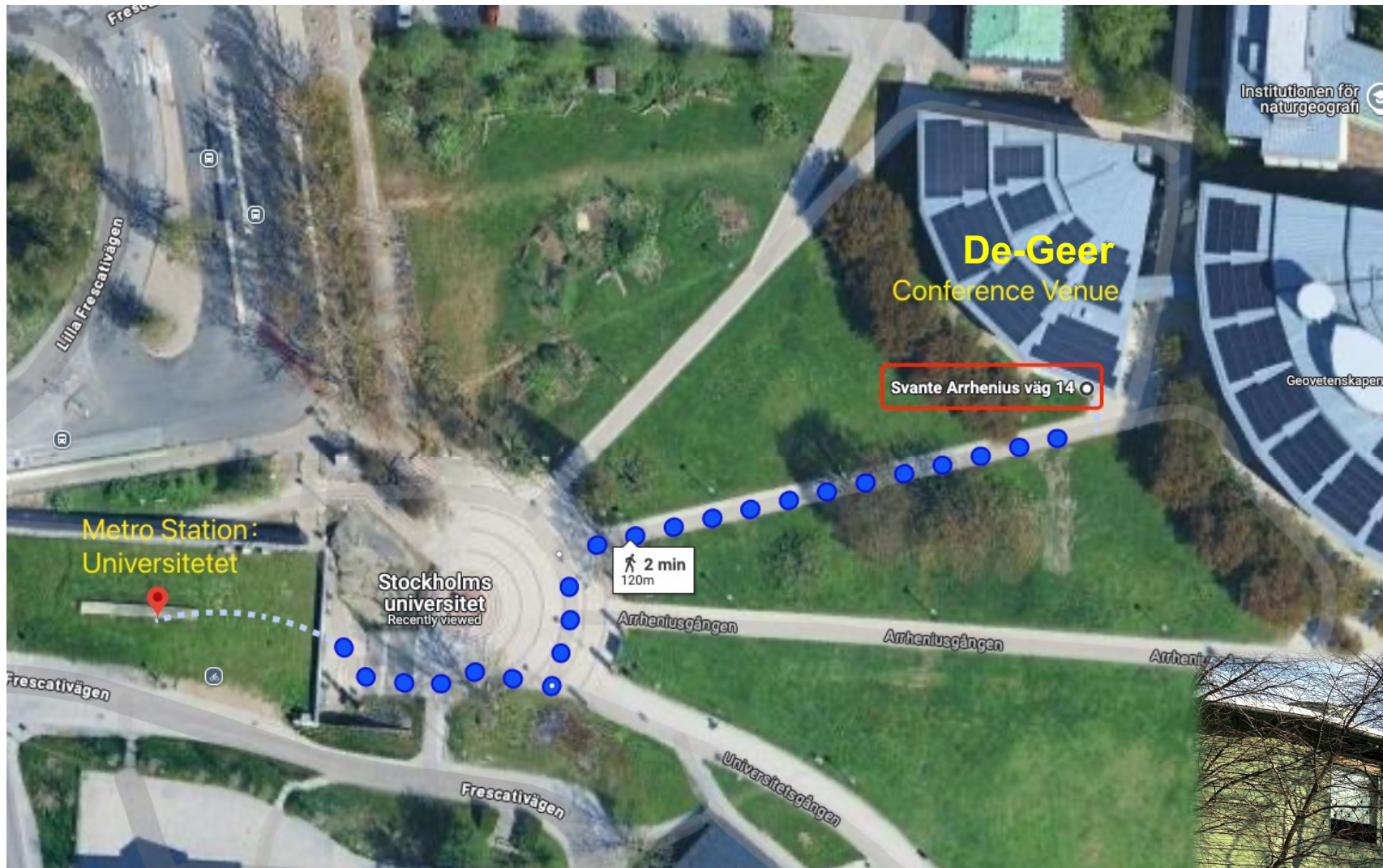
- **Arlanda Express Train:** The fastest way to the city center (Stockholm Central Station), taking around 18 minutes. Tickets can be purchased online or at the airport. <https://www.arlandaexpress.com>
- **Commuter Train:** A more economical option, taking approximately 38 minutes to reach Stockholm Central Station. Tickets can be purchased online or at the airport. <https://www.flygbussarna.se/en>
- **Airport Bus (Flygbussarna):** Runs every 10-15 minutes and takes around 45 minutes to reach the city center (near the Stockholm Central Station) .

From Stockholm Central Station to Stockholm University ([Svante Arrhenius väg 14](#))

- **Metro (Tunnelbana):** Take the Red Line (14) towards **Mörby Centrum** and get off at **Universitetet** station. From there, it's a 2-minute walk to De-Geer.

Simply use your debit or credit card to check in and out of the Metro / Bus.

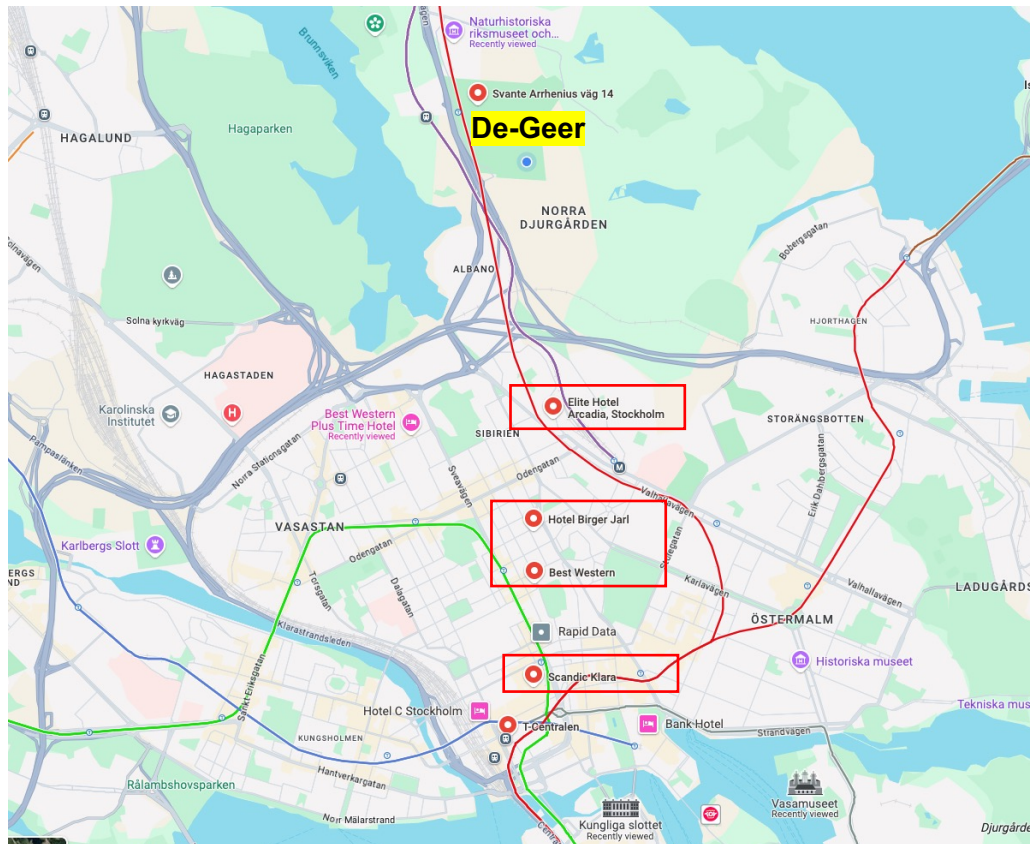
